

THE ROBERT G. & MARY ELEANOR ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP

The Starkville Community Theatre announces the Robert G. And Mary Eleanor Anderson Scholarship, to be awarded for the 2020-2021 academic year. This scholarship shall be for \$1,000.

Eligibility: persons entering college as freshmen or already enrolled in college as an undergraduate.

Applicants must major in theatre performance, technical theatre, or theatre education.
Applicants must be a resident of Starkville, MS; or Oktibbeha County, MS.

Application: Applicants should complete the one-page application form (available in their counselor's office at their high school, from Ms. Paula C. Mabry, 109 Dover Court, Starkville, MS 39759 or online at www.sct-online.org) and provide the following items as attachments:

1. A 200-300 word essay explaining their interest in theatre and reason(s) why they have chosen to major in the field.
2. A resume which specifies their previous theatre experience.
3. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a teacher, professor, director, or mentor in some aspect of theatre. One letter may be from the applicant's school counselor, or from a teacher or professor in another academic discipline.

Award: The Committee will contact the winner of the Anderson Scholarship. The award will be made in two equal increments, August 1, 2020, and December 1, 2020.
